

General Penalty Bylaw

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF TECUMSEH NO. 65

BYLAW NO. 7-2019

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE BYLAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY PURSUANT TO SECTION 381, OF *THE RURAL MUNICIPALITIES ACT, 2005*.

The Council of the The Rural Municipality of Tecumseh #65, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as "The General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
2. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Tecumseh #65.
3. Section 4 & 5 apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
4. Subject to the provision of section 3, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by the authority of *The Rural Municipalities Act, 2005*, or any other act, shall be liable to a penalty not more than \$10,000.00. In the case of a continuing offence, to a maximum daily fin of not more than \$2,500.00 for each day or part of a day during which the offence continues.
5. Subject to the provisions of Section 3, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by the authority of *The Rural Municipalities Act, 2005*, or any other Act shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$25,000.00. In the case of a continuing offence, to a maximum daily fin of not more than \$2,500.00 for each day or part of a day during which the offence continues.
6. Bylaw 2/1990 is hereby rescinded.
