BYLAW NO. 4-2015

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF MONIES OWING TO THE TAX ROLL

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Tecumseh No. 65 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Whereas when the Rural Municipality of Tecumseh No. 65 is owed money by a person or company at the end of the calendar year for services provided, including but not limited to custom work, dust-proofing of roads, gravel supplied, lanes mowed or graded or snow ploughed, equipment rental, fire extinguishing services, and those funds are more than 60 days overdue, the Municipality may add those amounts owning to the property tax roll of the affected property owner.

1. If the funds owed are to the municipality, by Council resolution, all overdue payments can be added to the property tax roll of the associated property owner. Upon resolution by Council, notice will be sent out 30 days in advance that the funds are still in arrears and that if they are not paid by the date on the notice they may be ordered to be transferred to the tax roll.

Read a first time on the 6 day of May, 2015. Read a second time on the 6 day of May, 2015. Read a third time and adopted the 6 day of May, 2015.
