BYLAW NO. 5-2024

**A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE PILING, PLACING, PLANTING OR ERECTION OF
STRUCTURES IN PROXIMITY TO MUNICIPAL INFRASTRUCTURE AND
INHABITED AREAS**

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Tecumseh No. 65 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Tecumseh No.65;
 - b) "Inhabited area" means any urban center, residential unit or livestock operation;
 - c) "road" means any road allowance within the municipality other than:
 - (i) a private road; or
 - (ii) a provincial highway
2. No person shall hereafter plant trees or shrubs or place stones, earth or gravel piles, portable structures, machinery, gravel pits, or other objects on private property within:
 - a) 90 meters from the intersection of two or more roads;
 - b) 60 meters from the center line of any road
3. No person shall hereafter erect an object greater than 150 feet high on private property within a radius of;
 - a) 450 meters of an inhabited area;
 - b) 90 meters from the intersection of two or more roads;
 - c) 100 meters from the center line of any road.
4. At the discretion of Council, no person shall hereafter dig burrow pits or dugouts within 100 meters from the center line of any road.
5. The council may, by order, direct the owner of any private property upon which an object has been placed in contravention of the provisions of Section 2 and 3 hereof, to remove the same within a time stated in such order and the provisions of Section 364 (4) (a) of The Municipalities Act shall apply, mutatis mutandis, if the owner fails to comply with the order.
6. Any person who contravenes the provisions of Section 2 and 3 hereof is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction of the penalties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
7. Bylaw No. 11-2018 is hereby repealed.
8. Read a third time and adopted by Council on August 14, 2024.
